

## Graduate Institute of Human Resources Management Part-Time Program at the National Central University

- Article 1 The Program is stipulated to clearly define the study requirements for the EMBA degree.
- Article 2 The EMBA students of the Institute who have not completed the course of Management, Statistics, Economics, Finance Management, and Marketing Management (with passing grades) before enrollment shall have to complete the undergraduate credit hours before applying for thesis interviews with the proof of credit hours submitted.
- Article 3 The EMBA study is limited to 1~4 years; however, those who have not taken all the required courses or the Master's thesis may have the study period extended for one year.
- Article 4 The EMBA students should have completed at least 36 credit hours for graduation (including 6 credit hours of thesis writing).
- Article 5 The core courses of the Institute include Human Resource Management (Advanced placement: Management Science), Organizational Theory and Management (Advanced placement: Management Science), Business Research Method (Advanced placement: Statistics), Human Resource Management Economics (Advanced placement: Economics), Thesis Writing I, and Thesis Writing II.
- Article 6 The EMBA students of the Institute should participate in various educational, training and social service activities run by the Institute.
- Article 7 The EMBA students are required to complete the master's thesis independently in accordance with the thesis progress and procedures as follows:
